I write to request that you immediately take all actions possible to facilitate the release of the Epstein files publicly.

As Attorney General of the United States, you have the power to release sensitive documents to provide transparency and accountability in government to the American people. Today, Elon Musk alleged that President Trump is in the Epstein files, and that this is the reason they have not yet been released publicly. This allegation raises serious questions about President Trump's ties to Jeffrey Epstein, and the American people have a right to this information.

This administration and the Republican party trusted Musk with access to highly sensitive and classified data.
