To direct the Federal Communications Commission to revise regulations with respect to the definition of the term “prior express written consent”, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Spam Calls Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. PRIOR EXPRESS WRITTEN CONSENT DEFINITION.**

6 (a) REVISION.—Not later than 1 year after the date
7 of the enactment of this Act, the Federal Communications
8 Commission shall revise section 64.1200(f)(9) of title 47,

1 Code of Federal Regulations (or any successor to such reg-
2 ulation) to have such section read as such section appears
3 (as revised) in the final rule of the Commission titled
4 “Targeting and Eliminating Unlawful Text Messages, Im-
5 plementation of the Telephone Consumer Protection Act
6 of 1991, Advanced Methods To Target and Eliminate Un-
7 lawful Robocalls” and published on January 26, 2024 (89
8 Fed. Reg. 5098).

9 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Section 64.1200(f)(9) of title
10 47, Code of Federal Regulations, as revised pursuant to
11 subsection (a) of this section, shall take effect beginning
12 on the date that is 18 months after the date of the enact-
13 ment of this Act.

14 (c) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this sec-
15 tion may be construed to demonstrate that the Federal
16 Communications Commission did not, prior to the date of
17 the enactment of this section, have the authority to require
18 that prior express consent be in writing for purposes of
19 section 64.1200 of title 47, Code of Federal Regulations
20 (or any successor to such regulation).
