Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Warrenton Public Works Facility Modernization Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Warrenton, Virginia located at 21 Main Street, Warrenton, VA, 20186. The funding would be used for the design of renovations to the Warrenton Public Works & Utilities building. The current facility was constructed in the 1950s and has received few updates in the past several decades. The building has documented asbestos and plumbing and HVAC issues, does not meet ADA requirements, and is too small to fit the town's emergency response vehicles and snow removal equipment.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will make necessary improvements to a facility that provides critical services to a town of over 10,000 people, including building maintenance, snow removal, recycling and trash collection, and storm sewer maintenance.

This project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a).
