11	(h) No Buffer Zones.—
12	(1) In general.—Nothing in this Act shall be
13	construed to create buffer zones outside of the Gen-
14	eral George C. Marshall House.
15	(2) ACTIVITY OR USE OUTSIDE THE GENERAL
16	GEORGE C. MARSHALL HOUSE.—The fact that an ac-
17	tivity or use can be seen, heard, or detected from
18	within the George C. Marshall House shall not pre-
19	clude, limit, control, regulate, or determine the con-
20	duct or management of activities or uses outside of
21	the George C. Marshall House.
